Experience in Natural Resource Management-NRM



EFFORT is having rich experience in the fields of sustainable agriculture and NRM. EFFORT has facilitated number of projects focusing on NRM and the details are as follows:

- Facilitated 90 Watershed development Fund projects with the support of NABARD with the involvement of 16 grassroots organisations focusing the soil, water & vegetative conservation
- Facilitated UPNRM with the support of NABARD to develop the uncultivable land into cultivable through adopting soil and water conservation aspects and moving towards sustainable agriculture
- At present facilitating IWMP with the support of commissioner of RD, Govt of AP covering 5,000 Ha
- Facilitating APDMP with the support of Department of Agriculture fund by IFAD
- Facilitating WASH and sustainable agriculture projects in the states of Punjab and Maharashtra

Major achievements in related to NRM



- Enhancing the capacities 1,00,000 population on water, soil and vegetative conservation practices
- 90,000 ha land was treated with soil, water and vegetative conservation methods.
- Increased ground water table in the villages
- 20,000 Ha of waste land was brought under cultivation and the farmers have adopted water efficiency mechanism covering 10,000 Acres such as drip, sprinklers etc.
- o 10,000 landless families got sustainable livelihoods through livelihood activities
- 5,000 Families have stopped the migration
- Enhanced skills & knowledge on Good Agriculture Practices among 1.50 Farm families
- Promoted 22 FPOs with 10,800 farmers
- Reduction in cost of cultivation to 30% and 15% remunerative price to farm produce than the market
- Reduction of Crop Loss and sustained source of Agriculture income
 - Educated and making them to adopt 1 Lakh families on the best practices of WASH





- Awareness and Sensitisation of communities on climate change related issues,
 Mitigation and adaptive measures
- Capacity Building on Water conservation and Water Management aspects and finally increase the water use efficiency mechanisams
- Convergence with relevant Government line departments
