Subject: Conducting training for sensitization of community, public agencies etc. and other stakeholders across the country in equitable and sustainable management of water resources – Reg.

The undersigned is directed to say that as per Terms of Reference for preparation of State Specific Action Plan (SSAP) for Water Sector, data in respect of Water resources is required to be collected and compiled. In this context every State is being supported to formulate SSAP for sustainable development and management of its water resources by aligning the respective State Action Plan for Climate Change. To achieve the desired goal, National Water Mission is supporting this initiative through Nodal Agencies like National Institute of Hydrology, (NIH) Roorkee and North Eastern Regional Institute of Water and Management (NERIWALM), Tejpur, Assam.

2. Therefore, a need has been felt for sensitization, training and capacity building of Panchayati Raj Institutions, Urban Local Bodies, Water User Associations and other stakeholders throughout India in equitable and sustainable management of water resources with special focus on water conservation, augmentation, preservation and efficient use of water. Besides, there is also need for greater awareness on issues related to water at the level of community for collection of data in respect of water resources and forwarding to the respective nodal officers identified by the States/UTs for preparation of SSAP – Water.

3. In view of above, the Nodal Institutes namely NIH, Roorkee and NERIWALM, Tejpur, Assam are, therefore, requested to organize trainings for

sensitization, training and capacity building of Panchayati Raj Institutions, community-based local Institutions, public Agencies, Water User Associations and other stakeholders throughout India emphasizing special focus on water conservation, augmentation, preservation and efficient use & thereby data collection on water resources in the State.
